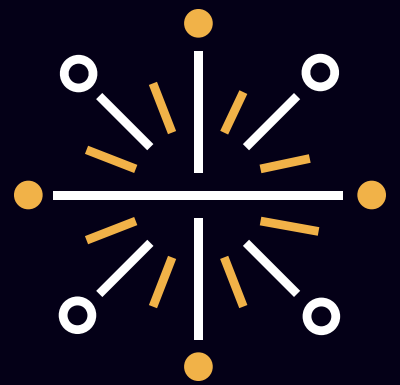


KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Did you know that fireworks can travel at speeds of up to 150 mph? Remember to keep everyone a safe distance away from firework displays and bonfires.

SPARKLERS

Only ever light one sparkler at a time, hold the sparkler whilst wearing gloves at arms length and be sure to supervise young children at all times.

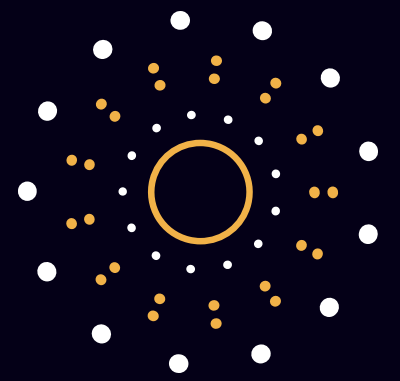


FIREWORKS

If lighting fireworks at home, be sure the ones you buy are suitable for the size of your garden and are marked with the British Standard Number: BS 7114.

HAPPY PETS

Pets can be very nervous on Bonfire Night. To help them feel more secure, try closing windows and curtains and popping on the TV to help mask the unfamiliar loud noises.



STAY WARM

Gloves aren't just for safety, remember to wrap up warm as November nights can be chilly, particularly if you're standing around in the dark!

GOOD NEIGHBOURS

If you're planning to have a bonfire or fireworks at home, warn neighbours in advance and remember, it's against the law to light fireworks after midnight on Bonfire Night!
